

ORDER ADOPTING MAGISTRATE
JUDGE'S SECOND FINAL REPORT AND
RECOMMENDATION

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636, the Court has reviewed the entire file de novo, including the magistrate judge's second final report and recommendation, and the objections to the report and recommendation that have been filed herein. The Court agrees with the recommendations of the magistrate judge.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. The second final report and recommendation is adopted.
- Defendant's Motion to Dismiss is granted;
- Plaintiff's federal civil rights and conspiracy claims against the United States are dismissed with prejudice and without leave to amend; plaintiff's tort claims against the United States are dismissed with leave to amend.

Plaintiff is ordered to file a First Amended Complaint on a date to be set by the Court after the District Court's Order has become final and the Court has screened the Complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2) that, with respect to this defendant, sets forth only plaintiff's tort claims against the United States.
