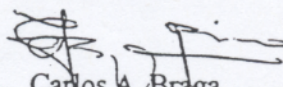
Dear Mr. Genevier:

Thank you for submitting your proposal. Following an internal review, we feel that it will not be competitive with other proposals we have received. This does not reflect a lack of intrinsic merit in your proposal, but rather that other proposals were more in consonance with the specific evaluation criteria and priorities of the program.

Reviewers were doubtful that this project would have significant impact in developing countries. Although the proponents are computer field specialists with all the necessary skills to develop web sites, the task they offer to undertake goes much beyond computerizing and covers economics, social and medical sciences. There is, therefore, a bias towards computer engineering which would lead to complex and expensive solutions instead of easy and flexible schemes more appropriate for developing countries. They felt that the production of good raw statistical data will depend on national statistical and health administrations. It requires, first, more qualified local staff and improved computer facilities.

On behalf of *infoDev*, I would like to thank you again for the time and effort that went into your proposal. The evaluation criteria used by *infoDev* are described in the document *Guidelines for Activity Proposals*.
